America's 911 Foundation Covid-19 Guidelines

With August approaching and the 20th anniversary of September 11th, 2001, America's 911 Foundation is excited to promote the 20th Anniversary America's 911 Ride. We are excited to welcome you and your fellow riders to experience the Ride to honor and pay our Respect to those innocents and heroes of September 11th, 2001.

America's 911 Foundation is pleased that you choose to participate in this event but ask that you follow the rules and guidelines outlined by the CDC and the various States that we ride through. Personal responsibility and doing what is comfortable for you and your friends and family will continue to be of great importance during your trip. While you are with the Ride, we encourage you to continue practicing health and safety guidelines, including physical distancing. America's 911 Foundation wants to share our commitment to flattening the curve. Our team encourages our participants to follow the latest CDC guidelines to ensure everyone's safety as well as some other practical measures:

- Washing and sanitizing our hands often
- Practicing social distancing of six feet between ourselves and others if necessary
- Staying home if you are sick.
- Covering your mouth when coughing or sneezing
- Wearing face masks if required

We respect anyone's need to continue practicing physical distancing, and urge everyone to follow all the [rules and guidelines](#) each State has in place at the time of the Ride in August 2021. You cannot press pause on safety while you are on a motorcycle; however, by being just a little extra cautious, you will help keep yourself, and your fellow riders healthy and happy moving forward.

DURING THE RIDE: Masks are NOT required while actually driving or riding when the motorcycle ride is moving. Wearing masks while moving may cause rider to lose visibility of the road if the wind were to "blow" the mask upwards over their eyes.

OUTDOORS: Participants of the America's 911 Ride will be required to abide by all local rules pertaining to the requirements of mask wearing and social distancing for said locality. We will present requirements daily during breaks.

INDOORS: All participants must follow the Covid 19 regulations of the locality and State where we stop while indoors. Again, the Foundation will do their best to communicate rules and regulations at each stop of the 911 Ride. However, it is the participant's responsibility to know and abide by the rules.

At this time of publication, all localities are easing the restrictions. Again, we will abide by each locality's requirements at the time of the Ride in August, 2021.

We understand the concerns regarding your safety while participating in the America's 911 Ride. The health and safety of participants and volunteers is our number one priority. We are encouraging each individual to practice current social distancing guidelines if they so wish, and adhere to the rules and guidelines outlined by the CDC and each state in which we stop (Pennsylvania, Maryland, Virginia, New Jersey and New York)

We can assure you that we are working closely with our partners in the business community, including hotel owners, during these unprecedented times and are communicating to them how crucial it is to adhere to operational guidelines described by the CDC. If you are concerned about what a specific business is doing regarding mitigating the spread of COVID-19, we encourage you to reach out to them directly.

CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) REMINDER:

America's 911 Foundation is committed to your health & safety. The Foundation urges everyone to follow physical distancing. Keep in mind, an inherent risk of exposure to Covid-19 exists in any place where people are present. Covid-19 is an extremely contagious virus that may lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and Riders with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. By joining the America's 911 Ride, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to Covid-19. Protect yourself and those around you by practicing good health habits.
