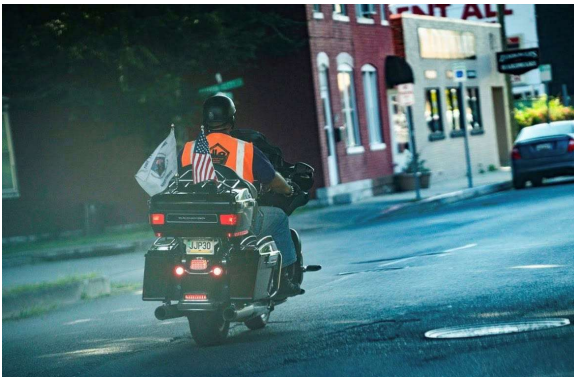
ROAD CAPTAINS ARE NEEDED:
