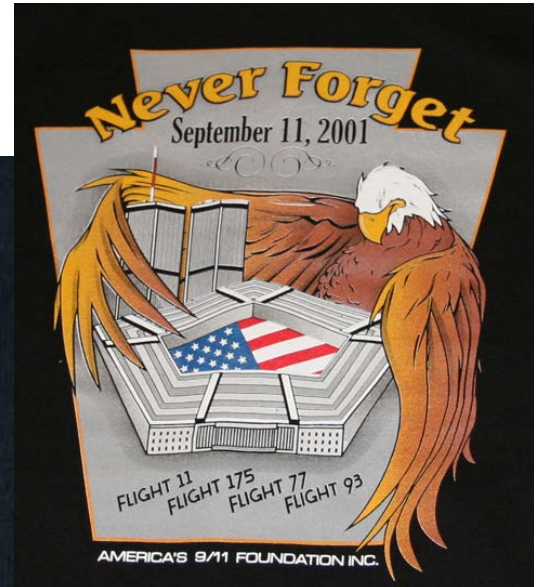

RIDE INFORMATION

Broadcast Messages:

During the Ride important Information will be provided via 'groupme', which is group chat app. For you to receive this information, you will need to have the groupme app installed on your phone. At registration you will be able to scan a QR code to receive Ride information. Once the ride is over you can delete the app. The App is Free to use or at no cost.

****this is not required but we feel it is a good way to help distribute important information.**

****This app is a one way communications path from the ride staff to participants.**

Additional Pumper Team members.

Honor Guards caring 3'x5' flags.

To do either you need to have been participated in a prior America's 911 Ride.

Pumper Team Info:

Riders who have been on the ride in past years to be on the advance support team. Pumper Team Volunteers travel apart from the main ride during certain sections of the ride in order to be at the fueling stations ahead of the main ride. Volunteer duties consist of traffic control within the gas station or teaming up with a partner to work a fuel pump. Volunteers all get a cool "Pumper Team" t-shirt.
